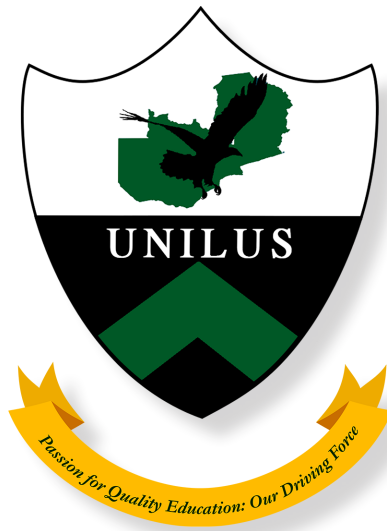

Introduction

The University of Lusaka (UNILUS) is a modern, dynamic private institution established under the University Act No. 11 of 1999, later replaced by the Higher Education Act No. 4 of 2013 and The Higher Education (Amendment) Act No. 23 of 2021. Founded in 2007 as the Institute of Corporate Training and Research (ICTAR), the University initially focused on postgraduate education through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Copperbelt University.

Since then, UNILUS has evolved into a fully independent and reputable university offering a diverse portfolio of academic programmes at Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral levels. Today, the University offers more than 24 undergraduate programmes, 43 postgraduate programmes, several postgraduate diploma programs, over 16 doctoral degrees, and a range of professional short courses tailored to meet industry needs.

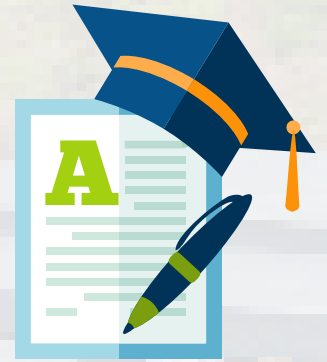
UNILUS is a thriving multi-cultural institution with a diverse and growing student population. The University maintains strong academic partnerships with institutions across the country, Africa, Europe and the world at large. It now operates three campuses in Lusaka, namely:

- Pioneer Campus – Off Alick Nkhata Road, Mass Media
- Law Campus – Off Leopards Hill Road, New Kasama
- Silverest Campus – Along the Great East Road in Chongwe

From an initial enrolment of only 71 students in 2007, the University now boasts over 16,800 students. With a distinguished faculty comprising experienced professionals and accomplished academics, UNILUS blends rigorous academic learning with practical, industry-driven skills.

UNILUS boasts of modern learning facilities and is led by qualified local and international staff, who are dedicated to delivering quality education. The University offers full-time, part-time (evening classes) and distance learning modes, with two enrolment intakes each year (January and June).

The University continues to grow from strength to strength, reaffirming its commitment to excellence in higher education and its role in shaping future leaders for Zambia, the region, and beyond.

UNILUS Grading System

The University of Lusaka applies a standardized grading system to assess All undergraduate student performance, determine progression from one level to the next, and classify graduation outcomes. Grades range from A+ (Exceptional) to D (Fail), with A+ to C regarded as passing grades. Student assessment is based on a combination of continuous assessment and end-of-semester examinations, ensuring a balanced evaluation of academic achievement throughout the semester.

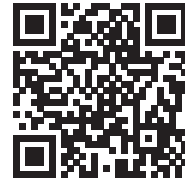

ZAQA Application Process

The Zambia Qualifications Authority (ZAQA) is a statutory body operating under the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Zambia. Its mandate is to develop and implement the National Qualifications Framework, ensuring that academic standards and registered qualifications are nationally and internationally comparable.

All applicants are required to submit a Zambia Qualifications Authority (ZAQA) Certificate of Verification for their academic qualifications at the time of application.

Applicants can apply for verification and evaluation of their qualifications through the ZAQA Qualifications Management Information System (QMIS).

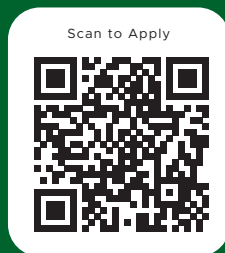
